

## **RV Campsite Rules**

### **Campsite:**

20'x40' camping site.

Enjoy a campsite with full access to all the entertainment this venue is offering, along with food trucks, and a few merchandise vendors without having to leave your area. You are also only a ½ mile walk to all the events that are being held at the courthouse for the Mountain View Eclipse Festival. 2 Festivals in 1 Location!

Take in gorgeous sunsets and mountain views sitting right beside the pond. You will also be allowed to bring your own fishing poles to enjoy some fishing in the pond. We will have some string lights around the pond. Our camping sites will be located right next to our entertainment area. We will have 6 porta potties on site for the event. You will have access to a water hose that you may use to fill up a few containers if needed. All RVs must be self contained, boondocking. No sewer, electric, or water hookups available.

### **GUIDELINES:**

All campers must have a debit card on file for any additional late fees or damage fees. NO checks will be accepted. We will accept cash or money orders. All campsite guests will be required to wear wristbands.

Your RV must fit within the assigned site. You will be allowed one personal standard size vehicle per campsite. Personal vehicles will be parked in designated vehicle areas for the campsite on the other side of the lot. If you have more than one vehicle, you will have to purchase a parking pass for each day, and park the vehicle in the regular parking pass lot. Each camping spot purchased will receive entertainment day passes for all guests. Maximum number of guests for each RV is 6-8 persons. If you have more than six- eight people, you are required to purchase an additional camping site. Our camping sites will be located right next to our entertainment area.. 30 feet. Therefore, expect loud music to be playing throughout the day until 10 pm, and then daily teardown after 10pm.

Quiet time will be from 11 pm to 6 am. Release forms must be signed by all members of your party prior to camping. Adults 21 or older only will be allowed to rent a site.

Campfires are only allowed in the covered fire pit and must be maintained and supervised at all times.

No disorderly conduct allowed, or you may be removed from the premises with no refunds.

### **CHECK-IN:**

Please arrive after 3:30 pm on your selected day.. Wednesday or Thursday. No early check-ins before 3:30 ( we will be at work). You must call our cell phone to let us know that you are in town. My husband is a police officer, so if you don't get him, call the other phone number that is sent to you in your email prior to checkin. We will give you a code to unlock the gate and tell you what assigned site you need to set up in. First come, first served.

### **CHECK-OUT:**

Everyone must be checked out by assigned time or will be issued a late fee of \$200 for an additional night. This will be charged to the credit card kept on file.

### **ENTERING/ EXITING CAMPING SITE:**

All vehicles must stay in the designated RV camping area parking spots when on site. If you leave in your personal vehicle, you will be given a code to the gate lock. You must unlock and

lock the gate upon entering and exiting the area for additional safety. There will also be a deputy that makes rounds for safety checks.

**FOOD:**

We will have a food truck on site. Your camping area will be located right beside Tommy's Famous Pizza. They are literally your neighbors for your stay. This pizza is delicious. You will be ½ mile from several restaurants located downtown.

**NOT ALLOWED:**

NO large dogs allowed, only small inside dogs are allowed. They must be kept on a leash at all times. They also need to be accustomed to loud music and lots of noise. Owners must pick up and dispose of all pet waste immediately.

No hunting wild animals, or swimming in the pond.

No glass bottles are allowed on site.

No illegal drug use. NO weapons, beyond what you have a concealed permit for. They should be kept locked away in a secure area. Law enforcement will be onsite.

**ACCESSIBILITY:**

Please note that we do have a small natural creek that separates the campsite and the other areas for food trucks, vendors, entertainment and porta potties. We are installing a small walking bridge over the stream. However, there is a dip, then the humped bridge, and then a dip up. This bridge is only 24" wide. IF you need something wider, please let us know, or you can bring something for your use to cross the stream. The width could vary based on the amount of rain we have beforehand. Contact us and we will see if we can help in any way. The ground is very unlevel due to being in a field, it has holes and very unlevel spots in some places.

**TRASH:**

You must keep trash in tied garbage bags and in the designated metal trash cans. Please have trash out to be picked up by 7am each day for pickup.

**WASTE:**

All human waste must be in RV or camper waste tanks. We do not have any access to sewer waste dump, water, or electricity.

**Supplies:**

Please bring with you all the supplies you might need. We are expected to have lots of people in town and supplies may be limited. You will want to have extra food, water, and extra medication.

**Emergency:**

I have posted links on the website for our emergency services. Please make sure you sign up for the alert notifications and review recommended guidelines to follow if inclement weather.

**Please note:** This is a field and sometimes things can be wet or muddy. Please take all precautions as needed.
