



### What is this?

In July 2024, before Pokémon GO Fest Niantic Wayfarer Ambassador PkmnTrainerJ put together a short survey, asking a few questions of Wayfarers who were in attendance at Pokémon GO Fests, global and in person.


The survey was done via links shared in Wayfarer communities and was closed after 113 responses.

Only the first question was required, with the others being optional, so amount of responses will vary

## Have you read the Wayfarer guide?

The first question, had two possible options, being a required one asked if the users had read the Wayfarer guide which Elijustrying had created. This listed several items, including things Niantic do not officially mention such as S2 cells

Only two responders did not understand the guide (1.2%) and were invited to add comments at the end




- Yes I understand

The second question delved in to whether those taking the survey had done Wayfarer edits. These are submitted in game via Ingress or Pokémon GO


95.5% of people said they had done this with only 5 users (4.5%) saying they had not



## Have you used Wayfarer to review Wayspots/edits/photos/locations?

Next, users were asked if they had reviewed Edits. This is done on the Wayfarer site.


Most users have reviewed Edits with only 3.5% of people responding saying they have never reviewed Edits.



# How would you rate your experience of submitting Wayspots, if you have done this?

The next section asked users to provide ratings for how they found the Wayfarer experience on a scale of 1 - 5


Most users (43.2%) rated their experience as 4/5 with only 2 users (1.8%) rating Submitting as the lowest score possible.

The next section asked users to provide ratings for how they found the Wayfarer experience on a scale of 1 - 5


Most users rated Reviewing Wayspots as 3/5, with 37.5% of users selecting this option.



## How do you feel about the change?

Recently, the Wayfarer review system changed from a rating of 1-5 stars, to a system of 👍, I don't know or 🦻 and updated some questions. How do you feel about this change?

Users were more split on this, however 47.3% of them said they were satisfied with the change, and 33.9% had no strong opinions.

The next question asked about whether users agreed with certain statements. This question & chart can be seen on the following slides, but some statements are presented in full on the other half of this slide.


#### The top 3 agreed with were:

#### Feedback

Finally, there was a free format text box for any feedback. A selection of comments are below and the full comments and data have been sent to Niantic

The guidelines can be very confusing. When you seek out clarification, unclear noncommittal answers are usually given. Appeals are inconsistent with quidelines. Edits still take far too long. I'm tired of reviewing edits to the church of Jesus **Christ of Latter Day** Saints.

I will refrain from going on a rant about the poor state of Pokémon Go. Wayfarer is mostly OK, the appeal team need to keep up to date with clarifications and criteria updates though.

Make the wayspot criteria clearer in game. So I don't need to review so much crap.

Please add

Criteria" back as a
rejection reasons
for things
specifically stated
by Niantic to be
rejected, such as
flag poles and
individual golf
holes.

Pokeemon go level is correct to add waypoints. Lower the level in ingress. Allow players of pikmin to add in waypoints. Get rid of the thumbs up and thumbs down voting.
