

Wayfarer Ambassadors at Pokémon GO Fest 2023

What is this?

In August 2023, before Pokémon GO Fest London, Niantic Wayfarer Ambassadors Elijustrying and PkmnTrainerJ put together a short survey, asking a few questions of Wayfarers who were in attendance at Pokémon GO Fest London.

The survey was done via QR code scanning and when closed on 11th August 2023 had 34 responses.


It has also been shared on the Wayfarer Community Forums, so some non-attendees may have also responded.

Only the first question was required, with the others being optional, so amount of responses will vary.

Have you read the Wayfarer guide?

The first question, with only one possible answer, being a required one asked if the users had read the Wayfarer guide which Eli had created. This listed several items, including things Niantic do not mention such as S2 cells.



Have you used Wayfarer to submit a Wayspot/make edits/add a new photo?

The second question aimed to see if users had submitted anything through Wayfarer. One respondent used the “Other” option to type “Pokémon GO” but most respondents have used Wayfarer to submit in some capacity.




How would you rate your experience of submitting Wayspots?

This question asked the respondents to provide a rating on how they found submitting Wayspots. All except one response rated it 3 and above out of 5. No user rated it as 1.

How would you rate your experience of submitting Wayspots, if you have done this?






How would you rate your experience of reviewing Wayspots?

The top 3 agreed with were:


-  **I enjoy reviewing Wayspots**

-  **It takes too long for anything to get accepted**

I'd prefer if they added more options under tags to better find the more specific tags for the nomination quicker but most of my issues may stem on how things may be reviewed judging from the title if one word can change the outcome even if that title can be edited once in game.
