## RACK AND PINION TIE ROD BOOTS, ONE OR BOTH

## REMOVAL

- 1. Remove rack and pinion assembly as previously described.
- Loosen inner and outer boot(s) clamp screws and remove boot(s) clamps and discard.
- 3. Slide damaged boot(s) off tie rod(s)

## **INSTALLATION**

- (a) If replacing one (1) boot, add 1/3 pint of specified lubricant to steering rack assembly via the left end before proceeding.
  - (b) If replacing both boots, position and secure with new clamps one (1) boot invert the steering rack assembly and add 1/3 pint of specified lubricant via the left end.

**NOTE:** In order to properly add lubricant to rack and pinion assembly, the rack and pinion assembly MUST BE removed and filled from LEFT side (pinion end) only.

- 2. Position and secure with new clamps replacement boot (or second boot).
- 3. Install rack and pinion assembly as previously described.
