WHAT IS “AMICABLE DIVORCE”?

Amicable Divorce is a process whereby the parties agree to resolve their matter between themselves with the assistance of attorneys, mediators, and other professionals, rather than being decided by a judge. The Amicable Divorce Network (“ADN”) can be used for divorce, child support issues, and custody modifications. The ADN is a group of professionals in the Metro Atlanta area that focus their practice on resolution rather than litigation. While both parties must agree to the Amicable Divorce process, it is not necessary that parties agree to the terms of a settlement before they start the process. This is where the ADN will assist with settling the case. Clients who wish to avoid litigation can use the ADN process to facilitate an expedient and efficient resolution to their case.

Litigation often becomes a stressful and emotional process which can deteriorate an already fragile relationship between the parties. An Amicable Divorce can be an important tool in maintaining a positive co-parenting relationship with your spouse. Members of the ADN will assist you in preserving a civil relationship with your spouse for the best interest of your children.
