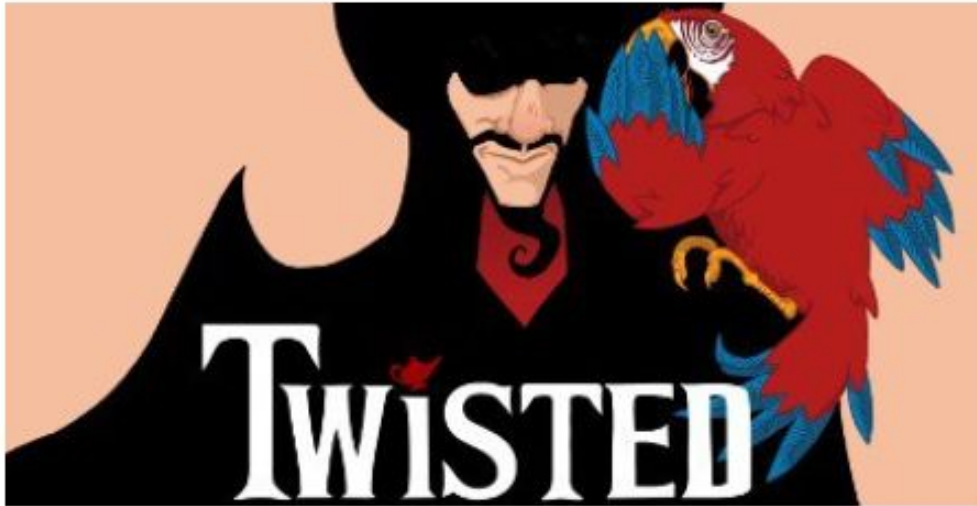

*as Professor Plum*

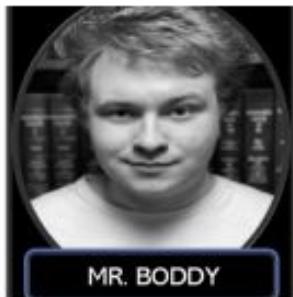

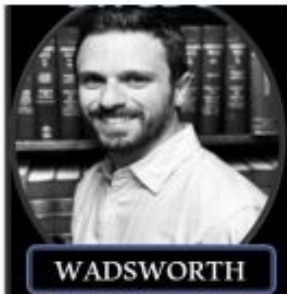


### **Sara Landry**
