You are voluntarily providing potentially hazardous services, and by signing below, you agree that you assume full responsibility for any loss or personal injury, including death, that may sustain as a result of treating COVID-19 patients while wearing PPE provided by HMAH, whether caused by the negligence of HMAH or otherwise.

By signing below, you and all of your heirs, assigns, and personal or legal representatives (collectively, “You”) agree not to sue and agree to fully release, indemnify, and hold HMAH, along with its affiliates, predecessors, successors, parents, subsidiaries, representatives, consultants, contractors, employees, volunteers, directors, officers, clients, assigns, and/or agents (collectively, “HMAH”), harmless from any claim, loss, cost, injury (including death), or damage (including without limitation attorneys’ fees and related costs) that arise out of your use of PPE provided by HMAH.

By signing below, you acknowledge that HMAH makes no representation as to the condition of or the safety of the PPE. You acknowledge and agree that you are not relying upon any representation or statement by HMAH other than what is set forth in this agreement.

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of North Carolina without regard to conflicts of laws principles.
