Initially working for Glasswall ltd as a Design Co-ordinator I was responsible for all post sales design and design correspondence. Glasswall ltd is a firm of specialist subcontractors that design, supply and install structural glass as an accredited dealer of the bolted glass system Pilkington Planar. Projects covered where mainly bolted glass orientated but did on occasion involved curtain walling systems.

Working directly with the two founder members of the company I had a heavy involvement with many aspects of the business. My duties included; production of design drawings, site surveying, liaising with clients, architects and main contractors, and carrying out pre-site correspondence. I also offered technical assistance to on site installers.

Whilst working as a Design Co-ordinator I was given the opportunity to take on some project management responsibilities, as well as estimating and purchasing.

My role with the company changed from Design Co-ordinator and I was promoted to Project manager. My project management role involved the organisation and running of projects, this included tasks such as procurement, buying, estimating, organising of site labour and ensuring installation deadlines were met.
