

Trail Information Project (TIP)

Welcome to the Ontario Road trailhead of the Bob Jones City to Sea Trail, a visionary project that began in the 1990s. The pathway's namesake, Bob Jones, was a tireless advocate for conservation of San Luis Obispo Creek. He co-founded the environmental firm Jones and Stokes in 1970 and in 1983 retired to Avila Valley.

TIP signs provide information along the path on flora, fauna and area history. This popular 2.5-mile paved multi-use trail follows an old Pacific Coast Railroad right-of-way to the small resort town of Avila Beach. Over 100,000 people each year enjoy biking, walking and jogging on the scenic pathway. Take a break at Avila Beach for a swim, picnic, and a visit to the Sea Life Center and you'll have a full day of fun.
