See Canyon Creek



See Canyon is well known for its large number of apple orchards. During the growing season a great variety of apples, as well as other fruits and vegetables, can be purchased directly from the growers. The creek that runs

through the canyon is a critical habitat for steelhead trout, an ocean-going form of rainbow trout. The creek runs all year.

Native to Pacific Coast streams from Alaska to California, steelhead spawn in freshwater for one to three years then migrate to the ocean, usually in the spring, where they may remain for up to four years. A marker on the creek side of the trail, about a mile down, describes in more detail the life cycle of the steelhead.
