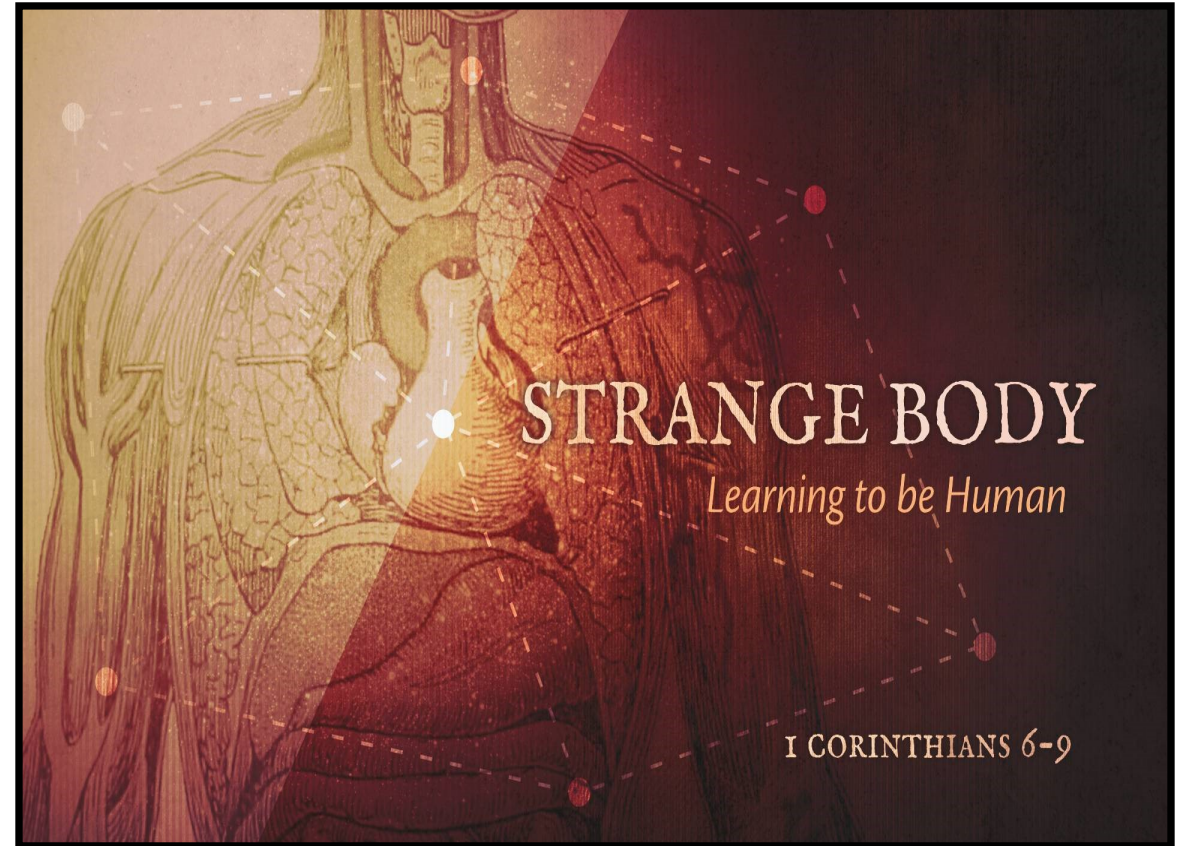

"Fat Tuesday" Mini King Cakes

"Fat Tuesday" is a tradition of one last feast before the Lenten fast which begins on Ash Wednesday. In centuries past, the Lenten fast was far more rigorous than today, and Christians were required to abstain from all meat and food that came from animals, such as milk, cheese, butter, eggs, and animal fats. All of those items needed to be used up before the fast began, and various Christian nations developed their own meat dishes, rich breads, and desserts for one last feast before the austerity of Lent. Thus the day became known as "Fat Tuesday."

Due to the current events, we have decided to change from the Pancake Dinner to Mini King Cakes that the youth will make to be ordered ahead for delivery or pickup on Tues. Feb. 16.
