Alfred Miller honored by Houlahan, Biden

West Chester neighbor, friend, father and decorated U.S. Army veteran Alfred Miller — who turned 105 this June — recently received recognition for his wartime heroism. Known to be the oldest surviving US Army veteran of China-Burma-India Theater of WWII, Miller was honored with a commemorative American flag pin, issued by President Biden. The White House certified gift was presented by Rep. Chrissy Houlahan (D-PA).

Born in Malvern in 1917, SSG Miller has been an active member of American Legion Post 134 in West Chester since 1947. He lives in the West Chester borough with his son, Stephen Miller.

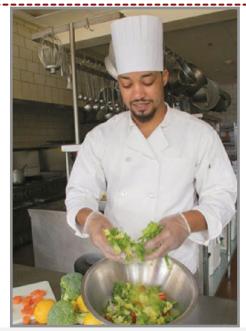

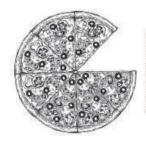

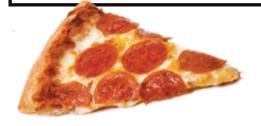

Gluten-free Philly Cheesesteak Pizza Recipe

- 1 Cauliflower pizza crust
- 2 tbsp. vegetable oil, divided
- 1 onion, thin sliced
- 2 bell peppers, thin sliced
- 1 tsp. dried oregano
- Salt, to taste
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 1 lb. shaved steak
- 1 cup shredded provolone
- chopped parsley
- 1. Cook pizza crust to packing instructions.
- 2. In a large skillet over medium heat, heat 1 tablespoon oil. Add onion and bell peppers and season with oregano, salt, and pepper. Cook, stirring often, until vegetables are tender, about 10 minutes. Remove peppers and onions from skillet and heat remaining oil in skillet.
- 3. Add steak in a single layer and season with salt and pepper.
 Cook until steak is seared on one side, about 2 minutes. Flip and cook until the steak is seared on the second side and cooked to your liking, about 2 minutes more for medium.
- 4. Add onion mixture back to skillet and toss to combine. Sprinkle provolone over steak and onions then cover skillet with a tight-fitting lid and cook until the cheese has melted, about 1 minute. Remove from heat
- 5. Top cooked crust with cooked steak and veggies, sprinkle with additional cheese and place under the broiler until cheese is
