

Natural Property Treatments

Many property owners want effective maintenance while reducing unnecessary chemical inputs. Natural property treatments combine careful diagnosis, cultural practices, biological or naturally derived products where appropriate, and targeted intervention instead of automatic blanket treatment.

Our philosophy is simple: use the least disruptive effective approach that fits the site, the goal, the label, and applicable regulations.

What 'Natural' Means in Practice

- Start with prevention and site conditions before adding products.
- Use targeted treatment only where a defined problem exists.
- Consider naturally derived, biological, or reduced-impact products when they are suitable and legally labeled for the use.
- Support soil health, plant vigor, biodiversity, and better maintenance practices.
- Monitor results and adjust rather than repeatedly applying the same treatment regardless of response.

- Mosquito, tick, flea, and nuisance-pest programs using appropriate registered products and integrated practices.
- Tree, shrub, and lawn programs.

- Use mulch, mowing, irrigation, and pruning practices that reduce stress.
- Preserve beneficial organisms and desirable vegetation whenever practical.
