

The He(a)rd Program

The He(a)rd Program is comprised of a variety of speech and language enrichment classes facilitated by a licensed speech language pathologist trained in DIRFloortime.

The program focuses on supporting young adults with speech and language differences who have aged out of the school system. Benefits of the program include improving communication skills and positive interactions with others and helping individuals develop skills for home and the community, leading to a more independent life.

- ~ Open to individuals 18 or older
- ~ Staff must accompany participants
- ~ Maximum of 4 participants per class
- ~ No refunds or make up classes
- ~ Classes held rain or shine
- ~ Cost: \$115 per 60-minute class
- ~ Register for a monthly package of classes
- ~ Number of classes in a package dependent on weeks in a month & holidays

He(a)rd In The Kitchen

Participants learn how to shop, plan for, and prepare food following recipes while exploring new foods and developing cooking skills.

He(a)rd About Special Interests

Participants engage in social activities which incorporate and embrace the special and individual interests of group members. Participants are encouraged to build connections related to their passions and expand social language skills with peers.

He(a)rd On The Move

Participants engage in expression through the use of movement-based activities such as yoga, nature walks, exercise, or dance. Classes are held on the property of Pal-O-Mine Equestrian where participants can interact with horses and small animals and utilize the adaptive sensory playground elements. There is no riding.
