

September 18th Denver Guaranteed Income Now Rally

What: The Denver Guaranteed Income Coalition is hosting a rally on September 18 from 11:30-1:30pm. The event will start on the West steps of the Capitol, culminating with a march from the Capitol to the Denver City and County building and some food and socializing afterwards.

The purpose of the event is to show Mayor Johnston and the Denver City Council that there's a huge group of GI advocates fired up to fight for a permanent, publicly funded GI program in Denver.

- Approx Noon - March across the park to Denver's City and County Building (1475 Bannock St, Denver 80202)
