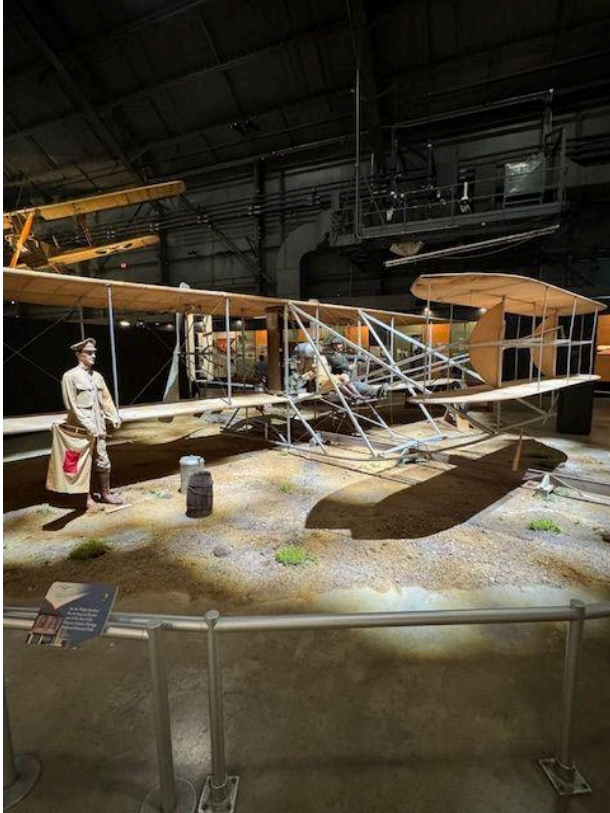


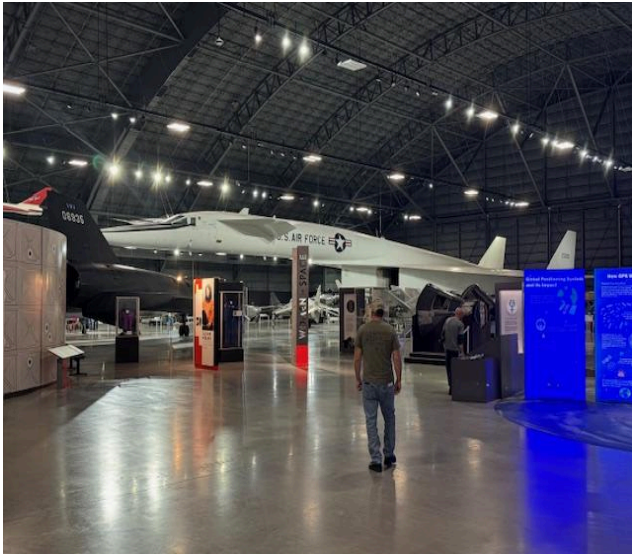

As a part of EWMA, the Georgia District is having their rally on June 5th through the 7th. NC-M2 Chapter will be riding down to Helen GA on Friday 6/6/25 being led by Joe Taylor. The meet location will be at the Ingles on Spartanburg Highway and upward Rd. with kickstands up at 8:00AM. This is a pretty long day ride there and back. Please let myself or Marty know if you are planning to go on this ride. We will send out email reminders prior to the event.

The next day Saturday, June 7th, Bob Topper is leading a ride to visit Bush Beans outside of Dandridge, Tennessee. This is the location of those Big Beautiful Beans factory. There is a small museum of the works there as well as a restaurant. Pretty great place to see and ride. This ride meets at Ingles on 280 in Mills River at 9:00AM.

On Saturday June 14th is "Cars in the Park" Mike Claywell will be leading this ride. This is a classic/vintage car show in Highlands, NC. However, this is not your ordinary car show. 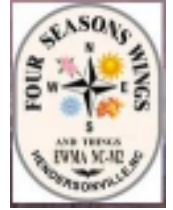
