**Fantastic news!** The picture of me at the highest point

on the Parkway can be done again. The Parkway is now open from North of Asheville all the way to Cherokee and just in time for the leaf peepers to rush to North Carolina. I might still want to go look during the week. This should be great news for the Pisgah Inn, restaurant, and store as they are no longer cut off from either end. Normally they close right after the leaves are gone, so there's not too much time in between. We might incorporate a Parkway ride in our hump day schedule.

September 5th through the 8<sup>th</sup>, there will be a group of us traveling to Savannah, GA for The Mighty Eight Museum. We will be leaving Friday morning with Brian Wittenberg leading the way. Located a short distance from Downtown Savannah, where the Eighth Air Force was activated in January 1942, the museum features over 90,000 square feet of exhibits, interactive experiences, artifacts and a collection of aviation art to engage you in the history of our nation's most storied air force, the Mighty Eighth. Fly a mission, stroll the beautiful memorial garden, and walk beneath the wings of the museum's restored B-17 Flying Fortress. Thanks to Gunnar for putting together a great deal of information for the planned ride.

If you are not going on the Savannah, GA ride, on September 6<sup>th</sup>, the TransAmerica Motorcycle endurance run will be stopping at "Dale's Wheels through Time in Maggie Valley where Matt will be welcoming the 100 + year old motorcycles stopping on their journey from Jenrette's Pier, NC to Florence, Oregon. They are expected to arrive sometime after 2:00pm. Some members are currently working on a plan to attend. Watch for more information by e-mail. This will be a tough one to miss.

After our September gathering, we will be having a ride around Lake James with lunch at Bones Jones Burger & Butchery. Joe Taylor took us on this ride a couple years ago and it's a great ride. This is also not too challenging. If all works out Joe will be leading us there again.

## **Riding in the Mountains**

### **Preventing Crashes**

- Ride within your limits. Pushing your limits pushes your luck.
- Plan your path of travel and speed to maintain control.
- Practice proper cornering techniques – Slow, Look, Press and Roll.
- Always look (scan) well ahead.
- Ride your own ride – Don't give in to "keeping-up" with other Riders.
- **DO NOT RIDE BEYOND YOUR OWN CAPABILITIES!**

If you are looking for additional tips regarding riding in the mountains, just ask, Bob, Marty or myself. We want everyone to be the best they can be. Also, plan to take some of our safety seminars when we offer them. We offer a tremendous amount of information to help you be a safe rider.
