### CHAPTER EDUCATOR'S CORNER





#### **Motorcycle Tyres**

O.K. I didn't spell tyres or tires right. It all depends on the side of the ocean from which you come.

To be a bit more specific how and where you park your motorcycle actually has a bearing on how well the rubber thingies that touch the ground will last.

One thing that will deteriorate rubber is UV rays. It will attack the rubber in a tire and that causes dry rot. The tyres are made with a UV shield that helps protect them. I park mine inside you say. Is it parked next to a running electric motor like that one in the basement freezer or refreigerator? Ozone from a running electric motor is especially hard on rubber. This is another cause of dry rot.

Oil will break down the compound in your tire. Armor All? Watch out for that stuff! It makes a tire shiny but it makes it slippery too. It also removes the UV protection from the rubber. Normal wear and tear is expected.

Now get out there and put some normal wear and tear on those tyres or tires. Just make sure you are on the proper side of the road.

#### **SOLAR ECIPSE INFO**

**WHAT IS A SOLAR ECLIPSE**: A solar eclipse happens when the moon casts a shadow on Earth, fully or partially blocking the sun's light in some areas.

**WHERE TO WATCH:** Find a nice, clear spot with a good view of the sky.

**HOW TO WATCH:** You can see the sun and the eclipse with special eclipse glasses.

**NEVER** look directly at the sun without appropriate eyewear.

**HOW LONG WILL IT LAST:** The total eclipse, when the sun is completely blocked by the moon, will last up to two minutes and forty seconds, depending on your location.

Totality begins in northern Pacific Ocean - 12:49 pm EDT

Totality reaches land in Oregon - 1:16 pm EDT

New Moon - 2:30 pm EDT

Totality leaves land in South Carolina - 2:49 pm EDT - right over Charleston.

Number of states with areas of totality/partial eclipse - 14/50

Totality ends in north Atlantic Ocean - 4:02 pm EDT

Average width of the umbra of the Moon's shadow - 68 miles

Average speed of the umbra of the Moon's shadow over the ground - 2288 mph.----- THAT'S FAST!!

Asheville airport - average cloud cover/Possible sunshine - 61%/54%.


