CHAPTER EDUCATOR'S CORNER





Friction Zone

OK, OK, OK! I know everyone knows what the friction zone is. For those of us who don't want to show ignorance it's the area in the clutch movement that allows partial power from the engine to reach the wheels until the clutch is fully engaged. It helps from stalling the engine or doing a wheelie when we first start movement.

Why is this important? It also aids in slow movement of the motorcycle. (Try pushing the beast up an even very gradual incline in a parking lot.) The friction zone makes that chore a lot easier.

It also aids in slow speed maneuvering. Keeping a constant engine speed (about 2 thousand rpm) and using the clutch in the friction zone can give you very good control in slow speed maneuvering in normal circumstances like just parking. If you need to ride for a longer distance such as through a cluttered lot to get to the other end because you entered on the wrong end and the place you want is over yonder try this method. Start moving set a constant rpm with the throttle and use the brake to control speed.


