



**Safety and Ride Coordinator –**

So many things happened this past weekend. One was Wings Over the Smokies where Bob Topper and I led a 225 mile mountain ride for 11 bikes on Friday. One of the highlights for me was among the riders were 3 Motor Maids.

In the late 30's, a young woman motorcycle enthusiast named Linda Dugeau of Providence, Rhode Island, conceived the idea that there might be a number of women who owned their own motorcycles and might be interested in becoming acquainted with one another. Linda wrote to dealers, riders and

anyone she thought might know of women motorcycle riders. After this extensive search, she compiled a list from which the Motor Maid organization was founded with 51 Charter members in 1940. The American Motorcycle Association Charter #509 was issued to the club in 1941.

They have been a continuous club now for 85 years.

On Saturday, Brian O'Brien and I spent the day at the G.A.S Vintage Motorcycle show. Bob Topper and Michael Riesman rode down to the show and Gunnar Holmes popped in as well. As always, we had a really good time looking at some fantastic motorcycles.

## **Tech Tip:**

### Riding in the Rain Impact on the Motorcycle

Rain impacts the motorcycle and the adjustments will need to be made by the Rider and Co-Rider.

#### **Hydroplaning**

- ⇒ Occurs when the water that the tires attempt to displace to the sides cannot get out of the way fast enough and builds up as a wave just in front of the tire.
- ⇒ Occurs when the tire rides up and “floats” on the wave, losing contact with the road surface.
- ⇒ The best defense to hydroplaning is to see it coming. If you are approaching a deep puddle and can recognize it in advance, safely slow down to allow the weight of your bike to keep the tires in contact with the road.

#### ⇒ **Braking**

- ⇒ Adjustments should be made while braking and or cornering in the rain.
  - ⇒ Use both brakes simultaneously
  - ⇒ Apply equal pressure
  - ⇒ Progressively squeezing the brakes until the desired pressure is attained
  - ⇒ Braking distance is increased on wet pavement, ease into it
  - ⇒ Slowing down without being abrupt is important on dry roads but **critical on wet.**

#### ⇒ **Cornering**

- ⇒ Give yourself more distance to slow down to an appropriate entry speed that will allow a steady speed or slight increase in speed throughout the curve.

If you are looking for additional tips regarding riding in the mountains, just ask, Bob, Marty or myself. We want everyone to be the best they can be. Also, plan to take some of our safety seminars when we offer them. We offer a tremendous amount of information to help you be a safe rider.


