The day was sunny and warm and perfect for a nice Saturday ride but for me it was family first. My daughter and granddaughter who live in upstate NY were here in NC for 2 days. I had to spend as much time with them as I could.

Unfortunately the second Bike Night was rained out and re-scheduled to June 25th which apparently had to also be canceled. Sorry for the short notice but I passed on the information as soon as I could. My understanding is the next one will take place, rain or shine, on July 16th at The Appalachian Brewery located on Locust Street in Hendersonville. I'll keep you up to date as things develop.

I did get to take a nice impromptu ride on Friday with our newest transfer member from Florida, Bill McGill and his visiting GWRRRA friend from VA, Tom. We had a great ride.

Ken, Craig and I along with Clyde Alexander (ACD West), visited the J Iverson facility on June 7th. No, we didn't ride as it was raining but we did learn a whole lot about the facility. It is on about 300 acres and has a staff of around 1,000 with around 275 clients. This is nearly a 4 to 1 ratio supporting all the residents. They are nearly totally self-sufficient in that they have their own medical facility on site, with several doctors and nursing staff, a dentist and a pharmacy. They have art and pottery classes, dancing of all sorts as well as horses on site for the residents. They go water skiing as well. Much of the needed equipment is made on site as they have full workshops to custom make wheelchairs and other items. The rumors of the past that this facility was no longer taking new residents is not correct. They continue taking in new residents all the time.

Bob and Diane Redding have agreed to take over the Progressive Dinner planned for September 7th. If you have not yet signed up to participate on this day of riding and eating, it's not too late. See Bob or Diane to sign up.

Don't forget, if you are planning to go on any of our rides, please have a full tank of gas and an empty bladder so we are ready and able to leave on time. This is why most rides start at a gas station.

GWRRA Chapter M2 Ride Schedule 2019

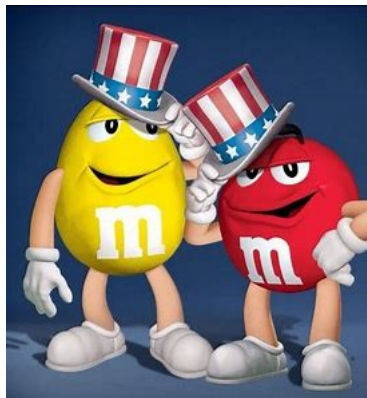
Gatherings are the 3rd Saturday of the month. Eat at 9:00am/meet at 9:30am. Golden Corral, Hendersonville.
