
NEW INFORMATION:

Riding Workshop:

Calendar for next season: After our first ride meeting had to be canceled due to the slippery weather conditions we were able to hold a meeting the following Saturday, January 13 th. This was very well attended and some great ideas were discussed. By the time you get this newsletter, I will have e-mailed to you a copy of the list of possible rides for this ride season. From that list we will be selecting which rides will be our extended weekend (overnight) rides. We will be setting the dates on a calendar.
