Safety and Ride Coordinator – January 2024 By: Dale Yager

New Information: This time of year, while we are getting a break in actual riding, we take time for planning. Our first TOUR MEETING will be Saturday, January 6th from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm at the Saluda Library (room upstairs). It's located at 44 W. Main Street. Parking is in the side lot off Carolina Street. Anyone and everyone is invited to participate. The fact is, the more the better. This is the first of three meetings to put together a ride schedule for next



summer. We want all your ride ideas. We need short day rides, Hump Day rides, and longer day rides. We need rides to special events. We need to list motorcycle events that are already on a schedule. We need extended weekend, overnight rides. All suggestions are welcome. To plan each year's schedule, we need help from our entire membership, not just a few people. Bring a list of all your ideas. We will try to incorporate as much as we can. Please let me know by either email or text if you are able to make it. If you can't make the first meeting, we will be scheduling another in February and a third in March to finalize the schedule.

Riding Workshop:

We have been talking about it, now we have time to make it happen. We are scheduling a workshop of classes for Chapter members to become better educated in all types of riding situations. Marty has secured a training room at the Salvation Army building at 239 3rd Ave E, Hendersonville, NC. The date will be Saturday 01/27/24 at 9:00 am. We expect about 4 or 5 hrs. of training. The Chapter will be providing coffee and pastries.

We will be training in probably our most needed course, **Group Riding**. Sure, most people can straddle a motorcycle, point it down the road and throttle up. This class gets more detailed on how to ride with a group of several bikes and the expectations when group riding. The safest way to ride in our group is when everyone follows the same guidelines.

We will also cover **1**st **on the scene response** regarding accidents and incidents. We will learn how to safely manage the situation, prepare for emergency personnel to arrive and learn how to keep everyone on scene safe. **Riding in the Mountains** will be our third topic. We all group ride, ride in the mountains and could be at the scene of an accident. Learning is paramount. Fire departments train, police departments train, and the military trains. We as motorcyclists should do the same. There will also be segments about riding in the cold, riding in the heat, and first-aid kit suggestions. We are also looking into First Aid and CPR classes for the future. We are progressively going to train this coming season. Don't just straddle your bike, point it in a direction and twist the throttle. Don't forget, we meet every Wednesday (**Hump Day Ride**) for breakfast at Eggs Up Grill on Spartanburg Hwy. If weather permits, we usually have a lunch ride to follow. Destinations are decided on Tuesday based on weather conditions. As the weather is changing, there will be fewer rides planned and they will be shorter and closer to home.

Tech Tip:

So when you have fat fingers, how do you get your side covers off your bike? Some of the older bikes were worse than the new ones but here's a trick for getting your side cover off. Use a paint can opener. I have rubber dipped the



end to protect the bike. The loop on the other end gives you something to pull on. I keep one on the bike and it works great. An additional tip; if you have a phone charger cord hanging on the handlebars for the occasion when



you plug into your phone, rather than leaving it exposed to the elements, use a Rubbermaid wire shelving rubber tip to cover the end of the plug.
