On the cusp: The weather is making a final turn and



we are on our way to a new season. That's what makes this time of the season so exciting. Our final tour meeting is Saturday, March 2nd at the Saluda Library, 32 West Main Street at 9:30 am. Coffee and doughnuts will be provided. This meeting is open to

all Chapter M2 members. Please come and help us finalize the calendar. Within a few days after the meeting you will get a copy of it by email. We just need a couple of people to edit it for accuracy.

Our CNO "Cooks Night Out" will be on March 7th. Sometimes we use acronyms and forget not everyone knows what CNO means. See the destination in this newsletter. Our next gathering is at the Golden Corral on **Saturday, March 16th** with a short ride afterwards. The plan is to ride into South Carolina to the Poinsett Bridge located at 618 Callahan Mountain Rd, Travelers Rest. Poinsett Bridge is **the oldest bridge in** South Carolina and perhaps in the entire southeastern United States. Named for Joel Roberts Poinsett, it was built in 1820 as part of a road from Columbia, South Carolina, to Saluda Mountain. Afterwards it's on to Mutt's BBQ for lunch.

At the end of the month (last Friday of the month) we will be having our first Ice Cream ride. For the Ice Cream rides we always meet at Ingles on Spartanburg Highway and Upward Rd at 6:00 pm and ride to an ice cream shop that is determined based on time and weather. This happens every last Friday of the month during the summer. These rides are not challenging or long distance rides. It's something for those who aren't attracted to the bigger rides.

If you haven't noticed yet, there is a pattern to our rides. First Thursday of the month is "Cooks Night Out", the first Saturday of the month is one of our longer rides which may also include challenging roads. The third Saturday of the month is our monthly gathering after which there is a ride. These are often shorter than the longer first Saturday rides but can still be challenging rides as well.

The last Friday, as mentioned above, are the Ice Cream rides.

Don't forget, we meet every Wednesday (Hump Day Ride) for breakfast at Eggs Up Grill on Spartanburg Hwy. If weather permits, we usually have a lunch ride to follow. Destinations are decided on Tuesday based on weather conditions.

Tech Tip: Goldwing cheat sheet:

Front and rear wheel removal:

Loosen pinch bolts on the right side

Break main axle bolt loose

Loosen pinch bolts on left side

Remove axle shaft note spacer location

Install:

Install axle shaft to indicator line.

Tighten left pinch bolts to 16 f/p

Install axle nut, tighten to 43 f/p

Tighten right side pinch bolts to 16 f/p

Re-Install brake calipers:

Left side 23 f/p

Right side 24 f/p

Reinstall brake covers and front fender.

Bolt w/ Rubber is bottom bolt.

Rear wheel lug nuts Tighten to 80 f/p

Oil change drain bolt 25 f/p

Engine oil filter 19 f/p

Final drive oil bolt 15 f/p

Spark plug gap 1mm

Spark plug torque 13 f/p
