Cost is \$85.00. If you are interested you should go on-line and sign up right away. You may have to search Motorcycle safety. It was difficult to find.

Once you get to this page, <u>https://www.blueridge.edu/programs-courses/personal-enrichment/motorcycle-safety/</u> near the top is a link to register on line (CE). Follow that link to courses. You need to go to page 4 where it is located near the top of the page. Make sure you click the box for Course # 8057-603. You then proceed to check out and follow the rest of the links. Please let me know if you register for this class so I know who to expect.

Tech tip: Torque specs, what are they? The manufacturer has tested and determined exactly how tight you can snug up a nut or bolt for it to do its job but not so much as to strip out the threads they are tightening onto. In the case of Honda Goldwings they are usually measured in Ft lbs. To get the correct tightness you need a special adjustable torque wrench that will let you know when you have reached the magic number set by the manufacturer. Too loose and things may leak, drip, loosen, etc. Too tight and you may have ruined that part of your motorcycle. This applies to oil drain bolts, brake calipers bolts, lug nuts and a whole variety of nuts and bolts. Don't know what is the right torque spec? It's in the front of the repair manual as well as your owner's book.




