#### RIDE COORDINATOR

Did I mention I had a screw in my back tire? I last rode the bike the day of our Road Captains class and basically rode from home to the gathering at the Golden Corral then to the Hendersonville Fire Department and finally back home. I had my sister visiting so the bike sat for nearly a week.

Friday night, 30 minutes before leaving for the ice cream ride I got on the Wing. It felt like it was sitting low so I hit my tire pressure monitor and it read 7 lbs. in the back tire. This is an o crap moment. I have had way too many of the same o crap moments. I think 5 or 6 times with the back tire of the 2008 Wing and now starting again with the 2016 model. Luckily I had the Valkyrie to use for the ride. Bob Topper thinks I am keeping magnets inside the tire and at this point I can't dispute that.

Make sure you routinely inspect your bike and tires. We talk about the T-CLOCK inspection on your bikes; you really do need to do it. In the past I have found a screw in a tire but was able to remove it before it caused unrepairable damage. Hopefully my problem can get you to check things out that might save you some time and money.



### Chattanooga TN Weekend: Friday June 28th through Sunday June 30th

We have one of our overnight weekend rides planned for Chattanooga, TN as the destination. Chattanooga was established in 1838 and is rich in history. In 1928 Ruby Falls was discovered by Leo Lambert who named the falls after his wife. They had a 20 million dollar upgrade in 2018. Think you have seen falls in the past? Never like this one! This is underground in a cavern.

Maybe you want to ride the incline railroad, or see Rock City. Myself, I am looking forward to the Coker Museum of cars and motorcycles. A museum started by the Coker tire company who has a passion for the old stuff. Admission is \$10.00 per person, Sr. @ 65 and Vets \$8.00. When is the last time you went to the zoo? Tickets are \$10.95 per person and \$8.95 for seniors 65 and older. Military or Veteran ID gets you in free and ½ off for up to 3 dependents. There is also an outstanding Aquarium you can visit for \$34.95 per person.

If you are planning to go, we need to know ASAP.
