Notes from the Ride Coordinator:

What to do after a motorcycle accident, there are some critical steps that need to be taken.

- 1) Collect Contact Information
- 2) Call the Police
- 3) Take Note of your Surroundings
- 4) Talk to Witnesses
- 5) Never Admit Fault
- 6) Alert Your Insurance Company

- 1) Once everyone is safety out of the roadway, exchange information with anyone else involved in the crash.
- 2) Call 911 to get the police to the scene of the accident as soon as possible. If damages are over \$500 be sure to file a police report and if anyone is injured, be sure to request medical attention.
- 3) Try to take notice of the important information about the accident if possible.
- 4) Eyewitnesses to an accident are an important legal matter and if possible interview everyone who witnessed the accident.
- 5) NEVER Admit Fault. Be careful what you say: statements at the accident scene can have serious legal consequences down the road.
- 6) Alert Your Insurance Company. Provide all of the information you collected from witnesses and people involved in the accident, just like step 5 never admit fault.

Hope this helps not only in motorcycle accidents but also vehicle accidents as well.

So ride safe, be alert and have fun.
