What can I say about the Bon Fire? We had more than 20 people there, a great weather night, some stories were told and we all ate really well. It was a great time. It always is a great way to close out the season. Set aside Saturday, December 20th for our annual Christmas Party. This is in place of a meeting in December. Jim and Norma Brabb open their house around 3:00PM for a great time. More info on this in this newsletter.

We still will meet every Wednesday for our Hump Day breakfast. During the winter months, rides will be scheduled as weather permits. Breakfast is at Egg's Up Grill at 637 Spartanburg Highway at 9:00AM. We do ask for you to let us know by 8:00AM if you are planning to come to breakfast so we can let Eggs-up know how many to expect. We sometimes can be a very large group. You can let us know by e-mail, text or Facebook.

We have had a request to order more chapter clothing. This would be the polo style short sleeve. I have checked on this and we will be ordering again probably early January. Shirts cost \$30.00 for XS to XL, 2 XL are \$32.00 and 3 XL to 4 XL are \$33.00. They will include having your name embroidered on the shirt. This will include sales tax and shipping. So what is next? We will be scheduling 3 meetings to put together a ride schedule for 2026. One in January, one in February and the final in March. The first meeting is to bring to the table ideas for next year's rides. We typically plan two weekend travel rides. Interesting places to go and see type rides.

The calendar will include start locations, start times, and estimated miles to the destination to help people decide if they are interested in the rides. The dates, times and location for these meetings have not yet been set, but they will be soon.
