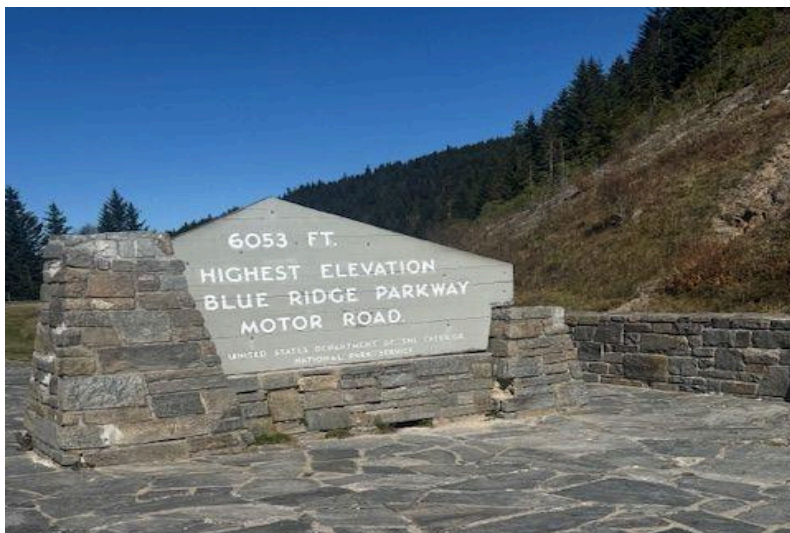

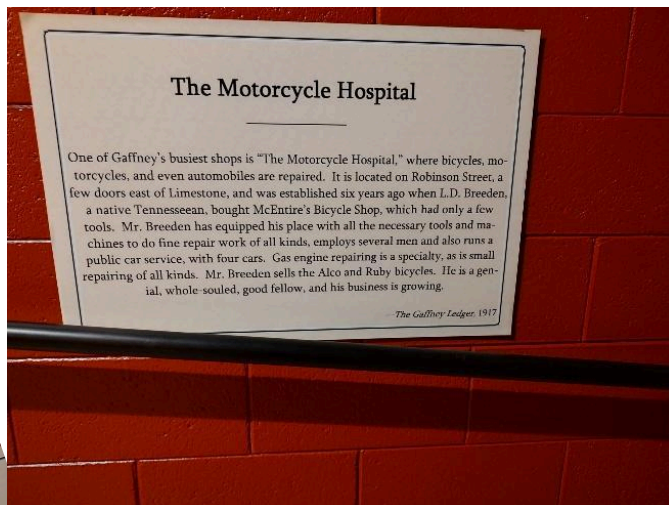
One of the most important rides we do of the year is riding in the Henderson County Toy Run. We have changed our meeting date for November to November 22 to co-ordinate with the Toy Run. Our gathering is of course at The Golden Coral at 2530 Chimney Rock Rd, Hendersonville. We meet for breakfast at 9:00AM. We use one of the meeting rooms at the front of the building. We start our meeting at 9:45 am. After the meeting we ride as a group to the start of the Toy Run. This allows us to pull in together and ride as a group in the Toy Run. Even if you are not planning on the meeting, you can join us in the parking lot after the meeting to join in the ride. Benefits are for local children. They request an unwrapped gift or \$20.00 per person. A BBQ lunch is provided.

November 29 th will be the Polk County Toy Run. We quite often also participate in this one as well. We will be meeting at 10:00AM at the Ingles store on Spartanburg Highway and Upward Rd at 10:00am. Tech Tip:

We are known as Four Season Wings and Things. What that means is often we ride all winter long. We don't promote any riding in the snow when we get it, or on the ice. Personally I won't ride below 38 degrees.

We must remember in the mountains water can run across the road surface and be in the shaded areas and freeze. As the signs say, Bridges may freeze first. Again personally it has to be a really nice day for me to get the bike out. If you do go out, the temperatures can drop really fast, especially as you climb into the mountains or it gets dark. It might be 40 degrees in Hendersonville but only 30 degrees on the Parkway. Always carry extra clothing to bundle up. Riding when your freezing cold is dangerous.

If you are looking for additional tips regarding riding in the mountains, just ask, Bob, Marty or myself.

We want everyone to be the best they can be. Also, plan to take some of our safety seminars when we offer them. We offer a tremendous amount of information to help you be a safe rider.

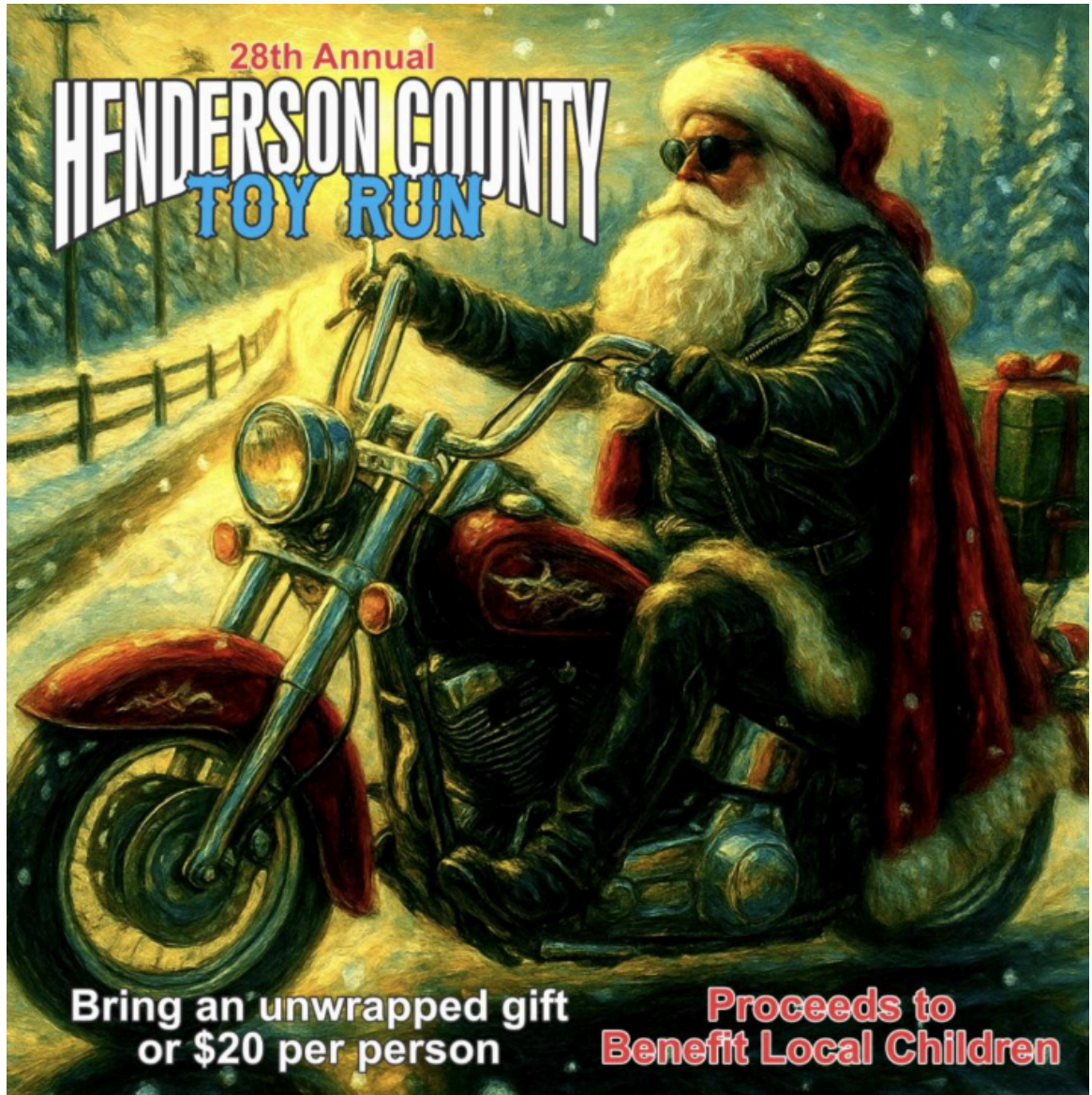
