Safety and Ride Coordinator – July 2025

The heat of summer is on, and our usual plan of just riding the Parkway is shattered. During the heat I always would ride the



Parkway to stay cool but even though they have been working on it and opening sections, a real ride up there is piecemeal at best. We will still work our best to ride what we can, when we can. As far as what is coming up this month, on August 2nd there will be a planning meeting at Mike's Pizza and Pasta at 11:00am for the Ride-In that we are hosting on August 9th at Janitzio's Mexican restaurant from 10:00am to 4:00pm. We plan to host both Eagle Wings members from the area as well as maybe getting a few new members. There will be prizes and games. The location is 1053 Spartanburg Highway, Hendersonville, NC. Marty can give more details about this event.

If you like vintage and classic cars, after our August meeting we ride to Forest City to "Hot Nights, Cool Cars." This is probably one of the largest car shows in the area. Again as a spectator, there is no admission. This makes a really great day. Just hoping for good weather for this. We will be planning a lunch break while we are out.

Jumping ahead to September Gunner has put together a great deal of information for the planned ride to The Mighty Eight Museum in Savannah GA for the weekend of 5th through the 8th. Also September 25th through the 27th is Wing's Over the Smokies. On our schedule, we will have a group ride to it on Friday the 26th. We will leave Ingles in Mills River at 9:00am. I was recently asked to provide short rides for Thursday, a half day ride for Friday, and a short ride for Saturday for the rally. I do have some rides in mind, however, I don't plan on being there every day. For those of you who are going for the weekend, I may be looking for help regarding this. This is a particularly busy weekend as our regular last Friday Ice cream ride is on the 26th and we have a ride scheduled to the Saluda Grill in Piedmont SC for the G.A.S. Vintage Motorcycle show. This is something I have participated in since the beginning of it and met up with my cousin Doyle for the day. In its first year, I took first place for Japanese with my Honda CB 200, the following year Jim Brabb also took first place for his rare Honda. There are some extremely nice bikes that are showing there and without the Meltdown taking place this year, I expect everyone will be there.

Tech Tip: How to do plastic body repairs. A couple of years ago, the back part of my front fender broke at the tabs where they bolt on. I bought a new front fender but had heard of people who used ABS glue to repair the ABS Goldwing plastic. I fixed my old front fender using it just to keep it on hand and see if I could do it. I was really happy with the results. Not too long ago Rusti had the same thing happen to her trike. She too bought a new replacement fender. She thought her old one was too far gone to fix. I brought it home and was able to put her front fender back together. Recently on Kathy's bike while it was here. Her side cover had some extreme heat damage. I again tried the ABS glue fix. I was able to build it back out to the correct flush finish. Shown below is some of the damage that was done to Rusti's Trike. Using the ABS glue I was able to rebuild the worn down mirror, front fender and front corner that had a couple of big cracks in it. I also finished it off with some fiberglass. Thanks to Brian O and Bob T helping we were able to get things straight and the body work is done. Now the final step of paint. The ABS can be applied in layers to build it up to the point of sanding it back down for some final finish work. Got questions about it, feel free to ask.


