Bike Safe NC is a free class given to motorcyclists by the Motorcycle Divisions of Police Departments in North Carolina. On Friday, August 16 th several of this group have signed up to take the class from the Asheville Police. The class is in Woodfin and starts at 8:45am



sharp! Those of us that are going together will be meeting at the Mills River Ingles at 7:00am. As of the typing of this article, they have 1 opening left. You must sign up on their website. If you do, please let me know you will be joining us. https://www.bikesafenc.com/ Still one opening if anyone is interested.

Next Saturday, 8/03/24, we have a ride to Shady Valley, TN. We will be meeting at the Mills River Ingles with kickstands up at 8:00am. This is a long ride as well as very challenging. It's not for the novice riders. The overall distance from and back to Hendersonville will be about 300 miles. Yes, that means at least one gas stop during the day. The route will include part of the "Snake" which is 421 from Shady Valley south. It does not include the upper portion as it would make the day that much longer. It still includes some additional twisty roads as well. There will also be some interstate riding. I need to know in advance, ASAP, who plans to go on this ride! As I know it is a long day and lots of miles, if there are no takers I need to evaluate it. Like any ride, the weather will also be taken into consideration.

The Sullenberger Aviation Museum tour is booked for October 5th and our tour time is at noon. The cost is \$16.50 each. We will be meeting at Ingles on Spartanburg Hwy and Upward Rd at 9:00am to get there on time. I have made reservations for 20 people and we still have openings. This is an Aviation Museum that is brand new. This museum also houses the famous "Miracle on the Hudson". Flight 1509 that left New York City on January 15, 2009 en route to Charlotte, NC. The plane was struck with birds and had to have an emergency landing on the Hudson River where everyone survived. The Captain was Chesley "Sully" Sullenberger who was credited with making the decision to land and saved the lives of everyone on board. This museum is a huge piece of American History and rightfully named "Miracle on the Hudson". https://www.sullenbergeraviation.org/

I reported a snafu on this at the meeting as it appears they changed people in charge of tours. That has since been resolved. At this time we have 17 people and everyone is paid in advance. Please see Dale in advance if you want to be added to the list.

After our next gathering on 8/17/24, Jim Brabb will be leading the group to the "Hot Nights, Cool Cars Show" in Forest City. We will be leaving right after our August meeting. There is no

cost to look at the cars.

If anyone is interested, the EWMA Rendezvous in Green Bay, WI is taking place August 29 through 31 st. Marty is leaving on August 27 th for this along with David D. They welcome others to join them. Get with Marty if you plan to go.

Jumping ahead just a little, September 6 th through the 9 th several of us are going to and staying at the Iron Horse Motorcycle Lodge in Robbinsville, NC for some fantastic riding, food and fun. The house has

already been booked and no additional rooms are available, however a member can make their own arrangements for a motel and join us if they wish. There will be additional info coming out by email for those who are signed up.

Don't forget, we meet every Wednesday (Hump Day Ride) for breakfast at Eggs Up Grill on Spartanburg Hwy. If weather permits, we usually have a lunch ride to follow. Destinations are decided on Tuesday based on weather conditions.

Speaking of Hump Day Rides: Group ride to Mt. Mitchell where we had a really good meal. An unusual note; there were 3 Honda Valkyrie Interstates on this ride.

Tech Tip:

Tying the thing down! There is a right way and a wrong way to tie down your bike if it needs to be transported by truck or trailer. Most manufacturers will let you know how to tie your bike down if you don't know how. If you are reading this, don't be afraid to ask another member. We are here to help and give advice to everyone. I did an article about this a couple years ago but since then the audience has grown. I highly recommend that you have and carry on your bike what's known as soft ties. These are webbed straps that have loops sewn on both ends. You use these to attach to very specific spots on your bike. I mention you should carry them with you. If your bike breaks down, or is involved in an accident, having them in your garage does you no good. If you break down, you need to supervise how your bike is transported. Keep in mind most tow truck drivers don't know much about motorcycles and any part that protrudes looks like a good spot to use their big metal hook. They also don't know how much to tighten the straps. I recently viewed a bike that had damage to it that I can only attribute to it being strapped down wrong and way too tight. If in an accident and you can't supervise, hopefully your riding buddy can oversee the bike being loaded. These ties are available through Amazon, Harbor Freight, or your favorite dealer. They also keep the nasty metal hooks away from your precious bike.
