Dear Kevin:

On behalf of the Board of Directors and all Veterans, I would like to sincerely thank you and all the Copperheads for the recent donation of \$1,010 to the Veterans Memorial Park of Jackson County (VMPJC). The Copperheads' donation is helping our efforts to complete, operate and maintain the Park to preserve the memory and history of our Jackson County military veterans who made the ultimate sacrifice, to honor all military men and women and to provide an educational resource to the community.

We are in the process of constructing a new monument which your grant will be applied to. It is the Monument to the Fallen Soldier and consists of a bronze statue, the Battlefield Cross, which symbolizes the location of a soldier on the battlefield killed in action. We expect the new monument to be completed by Veterans Day, November 11.

School visits, led by Veterans, are part of the mission of the Park to: "Educate our citizens, with an emphasis on our children, on US military history and military conflicts that have been fought to preserve our freedoms".

The Copperheads donation qualify them as a Silver Donor and will be recognized on the Donor Panel located at the entrance to the Park.

Kevin, please convey the Board's thanks to all your members and thanks again for your leadership and support of the Park and the Veterans that the Park honors.

The Ladies have been busy preparing for the holiday season! We want to wish you all a very Merry Christmas and all the blessings for a wonderful new year! Here's a special recipe shared by Corkscrew, Crowbar's Lady (Virginia). Enjoy!

Ingrediants:

35-40 Saltine Crackers

1 cup of butter

1 cup of Brown Sugar

2 cups of semi-sweet chocolate chips

Toppings to use (optional)

Chopped pecans

Red and Green M&Ms

Red and Green Christmas sprinkles



Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Line a 10x15 inch baking sheet with aluminum foil and spray with cooking spray.
- Place saltine crackers in even rows and set aside.
- In a saucepan over medium high heat, melt the butter and brown sugar. Wisk the mixture and let boil for a few minutes.
- Pour the mixture over the saltines and spread out. Bake in oven for 5 minutes. Remove from oven and sprinkle with chocolate chips and let it sit.
- Spread the chocolate out over the saltines and sprinkle toppings of your choice and let harden. Cut into pieces and serve!
