We believe in the ideals and principles expressed by the Founding fathers and the American Constitution. We seek to preserve and advocate those principles for future generations." The Copperheads merge the purest of American ideals and constitutional respect embraced by those with Confederate blood or not.

With larger numbers of Northern citizens relocating to our area to escape the ever-increasing size and scope of government in their States, many of whom ride motorcycles, we want to encourage them that they have a place "among us".

The Copperhead patch is representative of those from across the republic who believe in small government, constitutional integrity

and liberty. By adopting the name given to Northerners as a term of derision but embraced as a word of the endearment of liberty our patch is a mix of the liberty head coin along with the sacred emblem of our bloodline ancestors, the Confederate Battle Flag. Below it the words we are familiar with, Deo Vindice or "God Our Defender".
