VERNON COMMUNITY RADIO SOCIETY

1. The name of the Society is the **VERNON COMMUNITY RADIO SOCIETY. (“The Society”)**
2. The purposes of the Society are:
 - a) To establish and maintain a non-profit community radio broadcasting undertaking to serve the Greater Vernon area. (“The Station”) in accord with the provisions of Regulations and Policy for Campus and Community stations as established by the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunication Commission. (“the CRTC”)
 - b) To provide radio programming content (“content”), the majority of which is materially different from content offered by broadcasting undertakings currently licensed to operate in the Greater Vernon area.
 - c) To engage community volunteers as contributors of content and to provide facilities and resources for the training of volunteers.
 - d) To contribute to the development of local Canadian talent through content and promotion.
 - e) To assist such qualified personnel as may be required to carry out the purposes herein.
3. The Society shall operate in accord with the requirements of the *Societies Act* (S.B.C. 2015 c.18) as enacted in November, 2016.
4. Upon wind-up or dissolution of the Society, the assets remaining after the payment of all costs, charges and expenses properly incurred in the wind-up including the remuneration of a liquidator, and after payment to employees of the Society, shall be distributed by a majority resolution of the Board of Directors to one or more non-profit organizations, charitable foundations or educational institutions in British Columbia.
