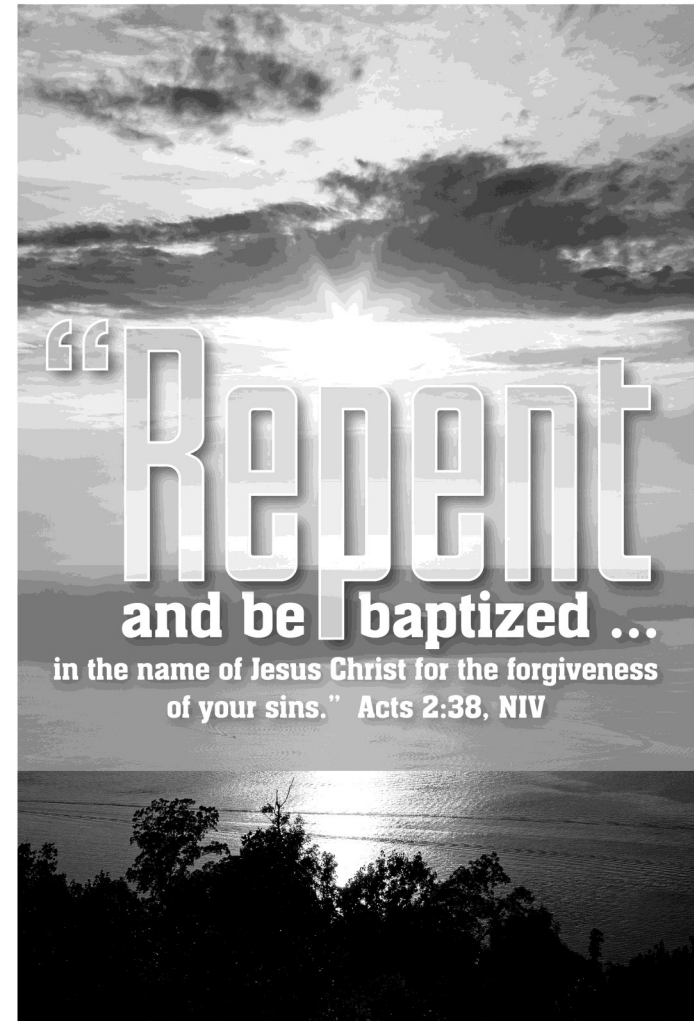

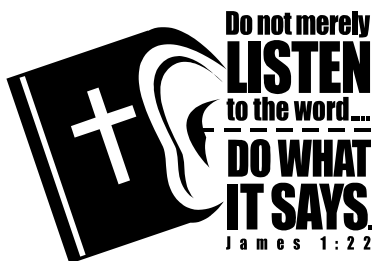
CHANGES TO COFFEE HOUR: SET UP & SERVE

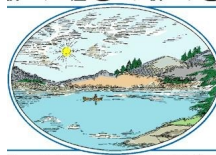

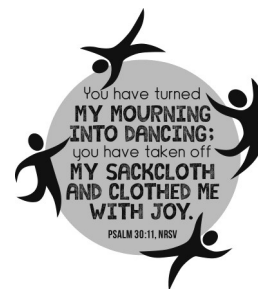
