



Thursday, September 18th, 2025 (8:30 AM-3:30 PM), Eastford Baptist Church in Eastford, CT.

Small Town Summits (STS), an offshoot of The Gospel Coalition: New England, focuses on ministering to small churches and small places in New England. One of the tasks of smalltown pastors and lay leaders is to learn how to more effectively counsel others, and to encourage and equip congregations to grow in offering wise counsel. This Summit will highlight the importance of God's Word and Christ's church for personal transformation in the life of believers, together with a call (and practical equipping) for each believer, including pastors/elders, to grow in our ability to offer wise biblical counsel. Breakout sessions and a plenary panel discussion will provide opportunities to get practical, go deep, and explore through questioning. This one-day commitment is a rich feast for just \$25. All are welcome; it's definitely not just for pastors!
