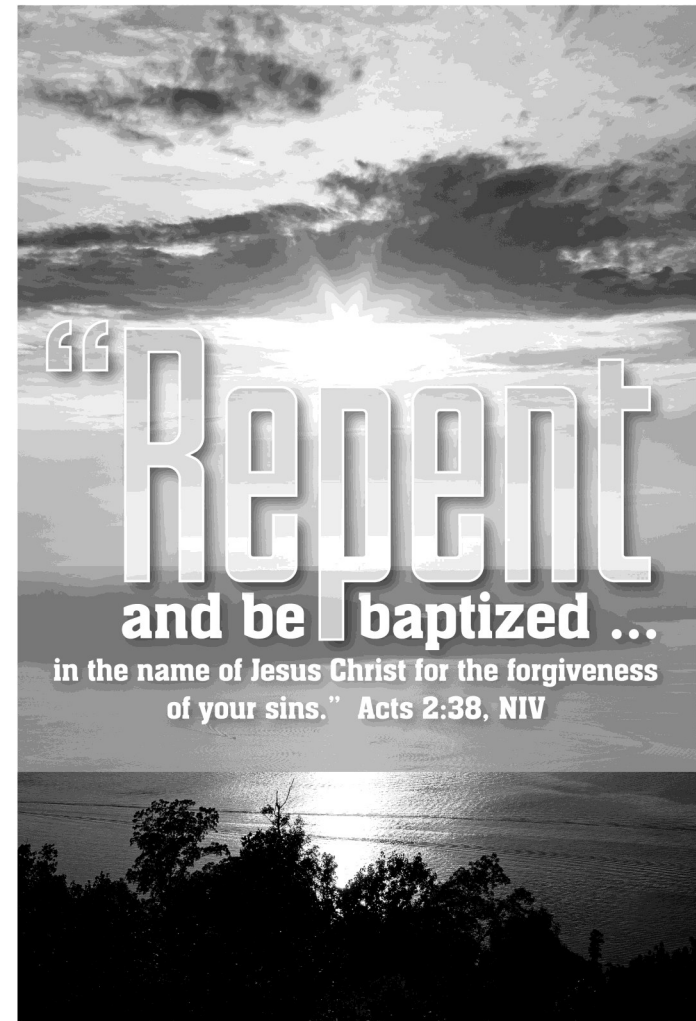

However, my elderly parents live out of state and sometimes need my help; I occasionally take vacations or go on ministry trips; and, as with every church position, a trained successor will be needed eventually. An **Office Team** could keep things running if I'm out of the office without undue pressure on anyone.

- Answering the phone, taking messages and checking voice mails during office hours is easy after a short tutorial. With the two cordless phones (Conference Room and Kitchen), you may pursue your own activities almost anywhere in the building and still answer the phone.
- Dealing with the mail once a day is even easier once you have my list of where everything goes.
- There's a list of typical daily jobs, Mon-Thurs. Some tasks can be done remotely, or whenever there's time.
- Computer skills aren't required for every Team member, but one or more people should be prepared to check emails, produce bulletins/flyers/lyrics sheets/sign-up sheets, and download/print newsletters. Bonus points to anyone willing to use ChurchTrac, our online database!

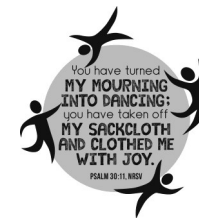

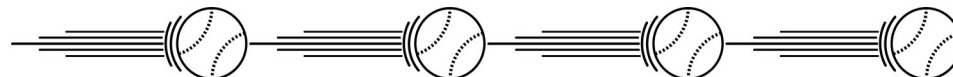
