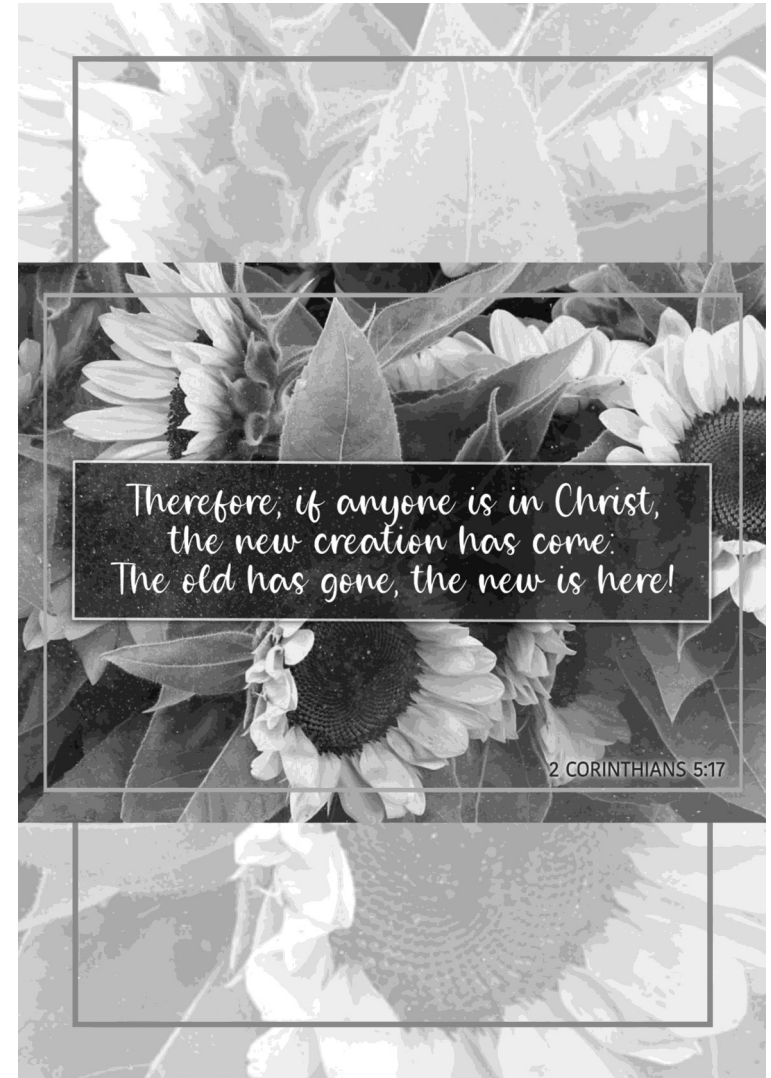

**If you use the enclosed shopping list for the Canton Food Bank, please bring non-perishable food items next week for our monthly collection on the Platform. Thank you!**

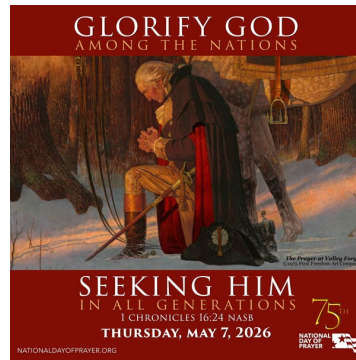
- The Elders and Prayer Team will be available after the service to pray with you. Need more privacy? A team will meet with you in our Prayer Room.
