

IMPORTANT: DURING WINTER MONTHS, please ONLY donate dry goods or items in flexible packaging in the LFP so they are still safe to consume after freezing. This past week we were forced to discard about 20 bulging cans after they froze in the extremely cold temperatures—ugh! Please donate cans and jars of food to our monthly church food collection (in baskets on the Platform every 3rd Sunday), or bring them directly to the Canton Food Bank at Trinity Episcopal Church, 55 River Road.



“GOLDEN RULE” FOOD SAFETY BEST PRACTICES, YEAR-ROUND:

- **Give fresh!** Ideally, all items should be well within “best by” dates. Our policy is to immediately remove out-of-date items when we find them.
- **Give high quality!** All items must be undamaged, unopened/unused, with packaging and seals intact. Our policy is to immediately remove items of questionable quality when we find them.
