

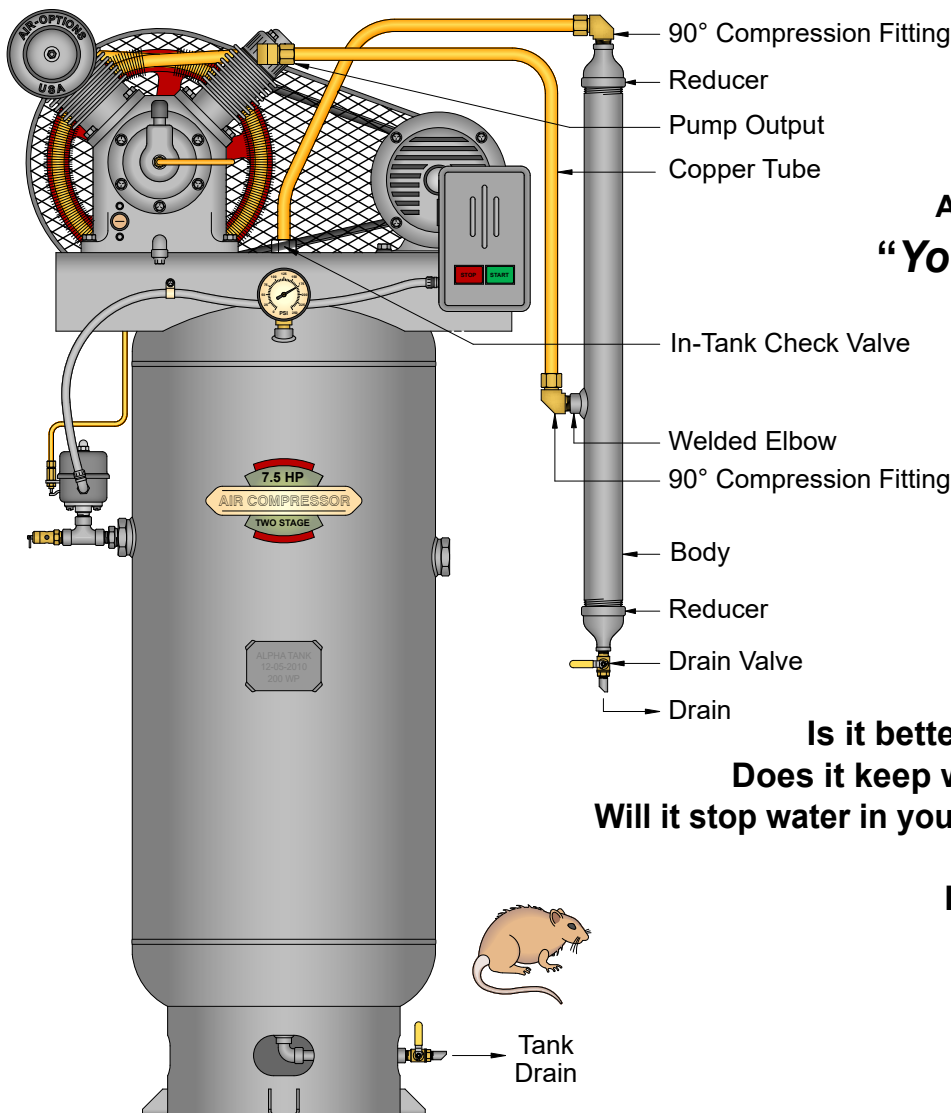

If you want to dry your compressed air, there are no shortcuts. You'll need a proper dryer.
