FROM THE "VOICE of the MARTYRS" (VOM), they are begging us to get involved by PRAYING: Praise God for faithful witness of our Christian brothers and sisters in India who have faced increasing hostility and violence! Pray for their strength and endurance as they work to advance the Gospel. Pray that God will replace their fear with His peace and they will know they are loved and prayed for by the global body of Christ! Of course "vom.org" will accept any monetary help for Christians in India who have suffered persecution or whose family members have been imprisoned or killed because of their Christian witness. Also VOM will help equip front-line workers with Bibles and ministry tools they need for discipleship and outreach.

India has escalated from a "hostile area" to RESTRICTED NATION", due to prime minister (PM) Narendra Modi who was elected in 2014 and re-elected in 2019. His leadership has advanced not a law, but an ideology called Hindutra or Hindu purity, that has resulted in persecution of Christians. Hindu nationalism is promoted chiefly by a right-wing paramilitary organization called Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS). Founded in 1925, RSS promoted – often violently – the "purity" of India as a Hindu nation. Though banned a number of times for heinous crimes, the affiliated political party, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), had by 1990's gained significant political clout in India government. . .

Modi became an RSS member at 8 years old and 1987 joined BJP, leading to election as chief minister of Gujarat state in 2001. US government denied Modi visa to US in 2005 because of his role in the 2002 Guijarat riots. He openly condoned riots where over 1,000, mostly Muslims, were killed. BUT, because of India's value as trade partner, Modi's travel privileges to US were reinstated, despite continued persecution as cited in reports from US Commission of International Religion Freedom (USCIRF). Since 2014 election of PM, RAA membership has increased 20%. When VOM Vice President for International Ministry, Aaron Miller lived in India, Christians would show him photos of RSS camps with youth wearing RSS uniforms that began as a few, then increased, growing nationwide.

Three primary tactics of RSS and other groups to persecute Christians: Legal opposition through anti-conversion laws that criminalize changing religions; mob behavior with groups of Hindu radicals attacking churches, pastors and congregants; and organized, planned attacks against Christians. Evidence of theses tactics was confirmed by an RSS training manual VOM obtained. Manual included instructions on undermining and attacking the work of Churches as well as suggestion of poisoning Christians water supply. One most chilling recommended tactic was sexually assaulting daughters of pastors who refused to stop their work!

During Modi's first term as PM, Christian charities with Western ties or receiving foreign funds, came under scrutiny. In three year period, 6,600 charities were denied to receive foreign funding by India, including US-based Child-development ministry Compassion International! Regardless of their explanation, was step toward purging nation of anything not Hindu. Two

years after Modi's 2019 re-election, Mother Theresa's Missionaries of Chairty was refused permission to accept foreign funding due to a falsified allegation.

Christians in India are experiencing similar type surveillance to that seen in communist nations, especially with informants. Hindu nationalism has even incorporated into country's public school curriculum. (Sounds like the communist attempts to take over our beloved USA!) Additionally radical Hindu groups are resorting to ground campaigns. September 2023, a subgroup of RSS called Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP) announced nationwide campaign to "reenergize" society on "Hindu dharma" (Hindu moral and religious law). The VHP plans to recruit "dharma yoddhas", or religious warriors to monitor what THEY consider anti-Hindu activities, including conversion from Hindu to another religion. Also how individuals are to be converted, forcibly, back to Hindu. Christians in India know what this all means. The word "warrior" implies violence.

While India's constitution includes laws to protect religious freedoms, their enforcement is difficult when the nation's leader is RSS member and proponent of Hindu nationalism. As a result Christians are arrested for dubious crimes like communal disharmony. January 1, 2023, a pastor was enjoying fellowship in his home with 20 Christians when large group Hindus showed up and began beating the Christians. Next day another group vandalized several churches, overwhelming police who were powerless to stop them. Eleven pastors arrested and charged with disrupting communal harmony. When lawyers arrived, someone at the hotel informed police and the lawyers were forced to leave. One social-media video brought to VOM's attention shows a Hindu threatening a Christian man, telling him he cannot distribute his literature nor allow other Christians to visit his home—all the time the Hindu menacingly waves a bamboo stick at the Christian.

While all Christian pastors in India are now at risk of persecution, that hasn't stopped their faithful witness. Front-line workers are preparing them for persecution, training them in how to respond if accused and arrested. Some pastors arrested, are embracing their time in prison as a ministry opportunity. Even if Modi and BJP are ousted from power in an election in April or May, no new government can undo the pervasiveness of Hindu nationalism. Still our Christian brother and sisters in India are willing to pay the price to proclaim the saving grace of the Gospel and VOM remains committed to supporting them. VOM is responding to persecution by helping Christians who lost jobs/homes, or suffered bodily harm in violent attacks. They also provide encouragement assuring persecuted believers they are remembered and PRAYED for by the global body of Christ. In 1967, VOM founder Richard Wurmbrand wrote, "The message I bring from the Underground Church is: "Give us the tools we need! We will pay the price for using them!"

Father, as I draw near to Thee in prayer, I am aware of the poverty of my love for Thee.
