After a change of address is filled out, permanent or temporary (Snow Birds), you will receive a confirmation letter from the postal service with instructions to bring the letter & ID to any local post office to verify your identity. There is a 20 day deadline to bring in your ID & verification letter to complete your temporary or permanent change of address. If this is not completed, the change of address will not go through the US Postal System. All ID's must be current. Expired ID's will not be approved.
