A Few Notes About Trash

Trash pickup is Monday morning. Bins should be out by 7 a.m. No yard waste in the bins.

Residents may drop items off (no charge) at the Columbia County Landfill, located on Hwy. 16 across from Pacific Town Hall on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. or Tuesdays 2-6 p.m. Extra charge for appliances, furniture, tires, and electronics.

Saddle Ridge recyclables will be picked up December 2, 16, and 30 and January 13 and 27.

A Few Recyclable Pointers: Only No. 1 and 2 plastic containers can be recycled. No plastic bags in the recycling bins. Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and cans (aluminum and non-aluminum) are all recyclable.
