Warm weather brings everyone wanting to spend time outside. Walkers, joggers, bikers and golf carts are out on our roads. Here's a few things to keep in mind and keep everyone safe and healthy.

The speed limit on all our roads is **20 MPH** please observe your speed.

Dog walkers- Pick up after your dog does their thing on a walk or in your grass area. No one else wants and shouldn't have to do it for you. Dogs are not allowed off a leash and not allowed on the golf course.

We have a lot of wild life roaming around our area.

Attached is an article that outlines WI laws on feeding birds and deer.

In Fort Winnebago, Wisconsin, feeding deer is generally not legal. Baiting and feeding restrictions are in place due to the presence of Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) and Tuberculosis (TB). While some exceptions may exist for wildlife viewing, feeding is generally discouraged and may be illegal depending on location and specific regulations.
