

# FSVP IMPORTER

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has adopted a program to protect the US Citizens against diseases, illness, contaminations from food produced internationally, with the introduction of the **Foreign Supplier Verification Program (FSVP)**.

In this FSVP, the responsibility to vouch for the Foreign Manufacturer falls on the FSVP IMPORTER. Some of your US clients/buyers are not willing to take that responsibility since it is a lot of administration work without pay. You then must find someone that can take that responsibility.



The FDA requires that the FSVP Respondent (the FSVP IMPORTER) must be an American business located in the U.S., must provide a phone number and email address available 24/7, speaks English fluently and have on hand the details of your Food Defense & Food sanitation programs, audits and certifications.
