How We Got Our Start!

We were founded in 2021 by Hannah & Clint Miller of Grant County. We got our start the year after Covid-19 hit hard & affected so many people world-wide. Hannah & Clint saw struggling families in need being denied by other programs or assistance not being available in the area for various reasons & took action. A Facebook group was created for helpers in the communities. Together they scoured the aisles for deals, saved what they could, & purchased extra gifts while shopping for their own families. We took applications through the month of October, & by December, we were able to help 21 families, 54 children in total, have a Christmas every child deserves, just in our first year!

Christmas for Kids-Southwest WI is a volunteer, donation-based program designed to help families going through financial hardships, who are in need during the upcoming Christmas Season, to be able to provide a Christmas for their families. The program is open to all children from ages zero up to 18 years of age.

Our mission is to be able to help as many families as we can within reason. We aim to be able to provide each child with 4-5 gifts to open for Christmas, along with a stocking, hat with mittens/gloves, & a full outfit appropriate for winter, this would include top & bottom. Sometimes we may be able to provide additional items such as socks, pajamas, coats, etc. provided there is enough availability. We do not promise to supply any certain gifts for any child. We are run on donations for all gifts given. Asking for specific gifts does not mean that your child will receive that item or be guaranteed that gift if your application is approved.

What to expect.

Each gift is individually wrapped with a gift tag in place labeled with the child's name. The gifts can be delivered or picked-up, whichever works best for the families receiving. Deliveries & pick-ups will be a week or two before Christmas. Be sure to watch our website and Facebook page for delivery & pick-up dates!

What is asked of the applicants?

Since this is all donation & volunteer based, we do ask that the program not to be abused. Those who do abuse the program by selling items generously given to them through this program will be denied in future years.



Who can apply?

Any family that is currently struggling with financial hardship & has children between the ages of 0 & 18. We ask that ONLY the families who have not applied for the Holiday Project, or any other Christmas related programs, apply. Those who have applied for other programs, but have been denied, are welcome to apply. This is to keep things fair for all those who are in need this season.

When can you apply?

We open the application process on October 1st every year & stop accepting applications on November 1st. If your application is submitted after November 1st, we cannot guarantee it will be received.
