Legacy Fire Training Academy prepares individuals to meet NFPA 1001 Firefighter I & II standards and achieve SFFMA certification—equipping firefighters with the skills and confidence to serve their communities safely and effectively.

Designed for the volunteer firefighter, the program combines flexible online coursework with hands-on skills weekends held once per month at the Legacy Training Field in Robinson, Texas.

## Requirements to Enroll:

- Sponsorship and letter of support from a recognized fire department
   Access to NFPA-compliant structural firefighting PPE
- Commitment to complete all online and hands-on training components
