For many English verbs, we add **-S** for he, she, and it.

HE **RIDES** A BIKE.  
IT **SNOWS** A LOT.  
THE BABY **SLEEPS** ALL DAY.  
ALEX **LISTENS** TO MUSIC



VERBS ENDING IN - O, - CH, - SS, - S, - SH OR - X → ADD **-ES**

HE **WASHES** THE DISHES.

SHE **GOES** TO THE SCHOOL.

FOR VERBS ENDING IN A CONSONANT AND -Y → THE Y BECOMES **-IES**

SHE **CARRIES** THE HEAVY BAGS.

THE BABY **TRIES** TO WALK.

**HAVE** IS REGULAR

HE **HAS** TWO BOOKS

ONLY **HE**, **SHE**, AND **IT** ARE DIFFERENT
