FOR VERBS ENDING IN A CONSONANT AND - Y



THE Y BECOMES -IES

SHE CARRIES THE HEAVY BAGS.
THE BABY TRIES TO WALK.

HAVE IS REGULAR

HE HAS TWO BOOKS

ONLY HE, SHE, AND IT ARE DIFFERENT
