



# Have or Has



When do we use “**Have**” and when do we use “**Has**?”

I **HAVE**  
YOU **HAVE**  
WE **HAVE**  
THEY **HAVE**

HE **HAS**  
SHE **HAS**  
IT **HAS**

## EXAMPLES

I **HAVE** A PENCIL.

SHE **HAS** A PENCIL.

## CONTRACTION TIPS



### Contraction Tip # 1

I have → I've

Use this if the action is already done.  
Example: I have eaten.

### Contraction 2

I have → I have

Use this if it is something you own.  
Example: I have a dog.

## NEGATIVE FORM OF “HAVE”.

We use “do not have” or “does not have.” We can make contractions too!

I **DO NOT HAVE**  
I **DON'T HAVE**  
YOU **DO NOT HAVE**  
YOU **DON'T HAVE**



HE **DOES NOT HAVE**  
HE **DOESN'T HAVE**  
SHE **DOES NOT HAVE**  
SHE **DOESN'T HAVE**



Use “**don't or doesn't + have**” only for possession of something. Example: I don't have a toy.

Use “**haven't or hasn't + action verb**” only with an action done. Example: I haven't eaten dinner yet.
